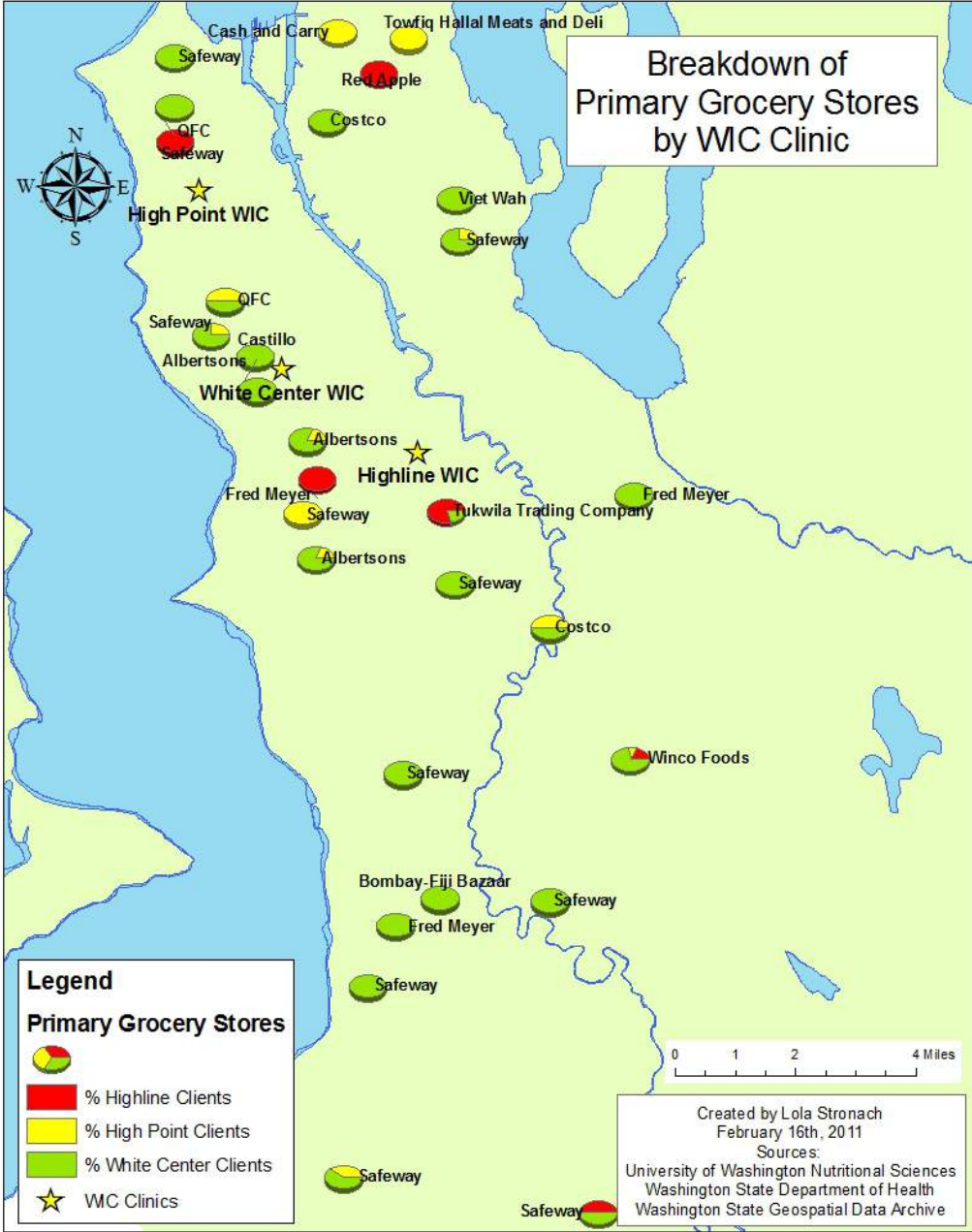


# Primary Grocery Stores



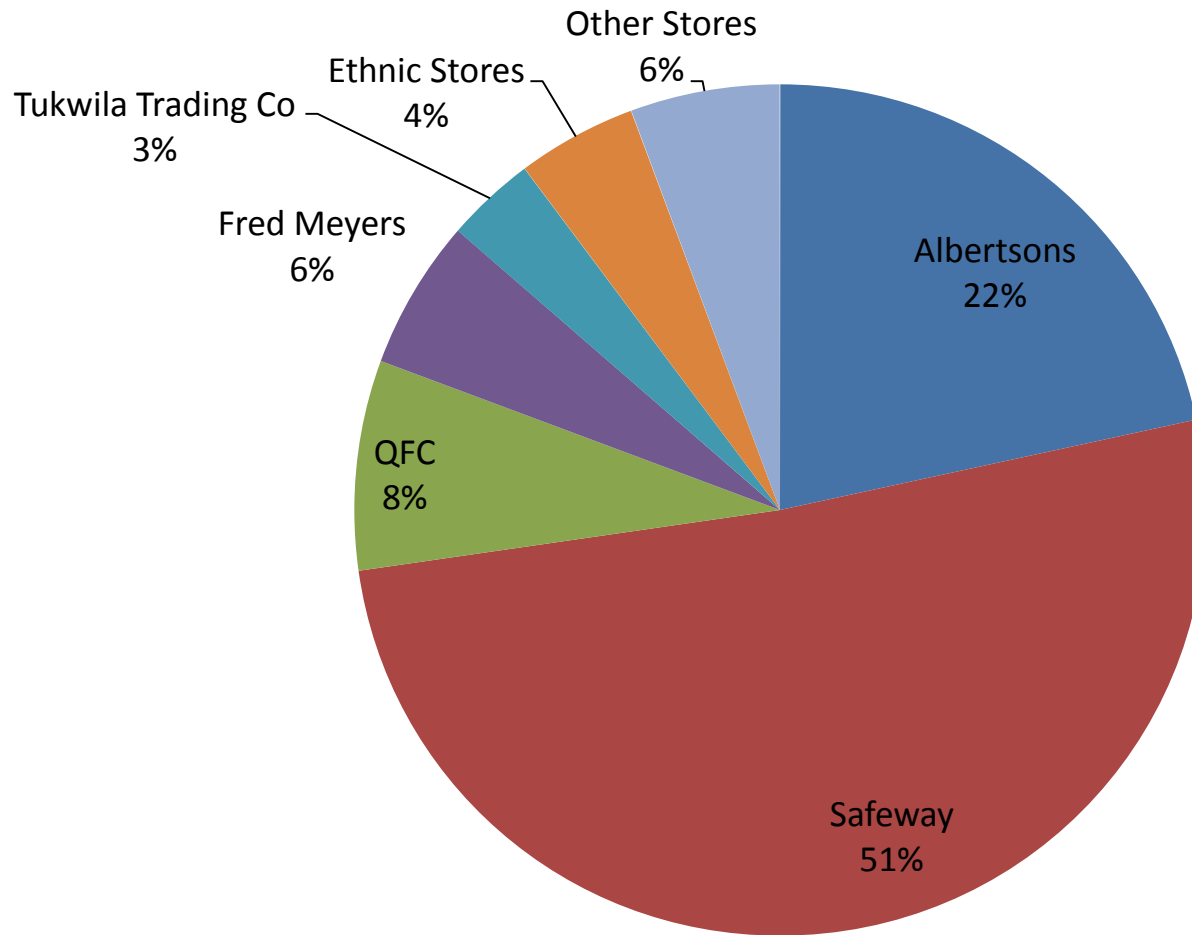


# Breakdown of Primary Grocery Stores by WIC Clinic

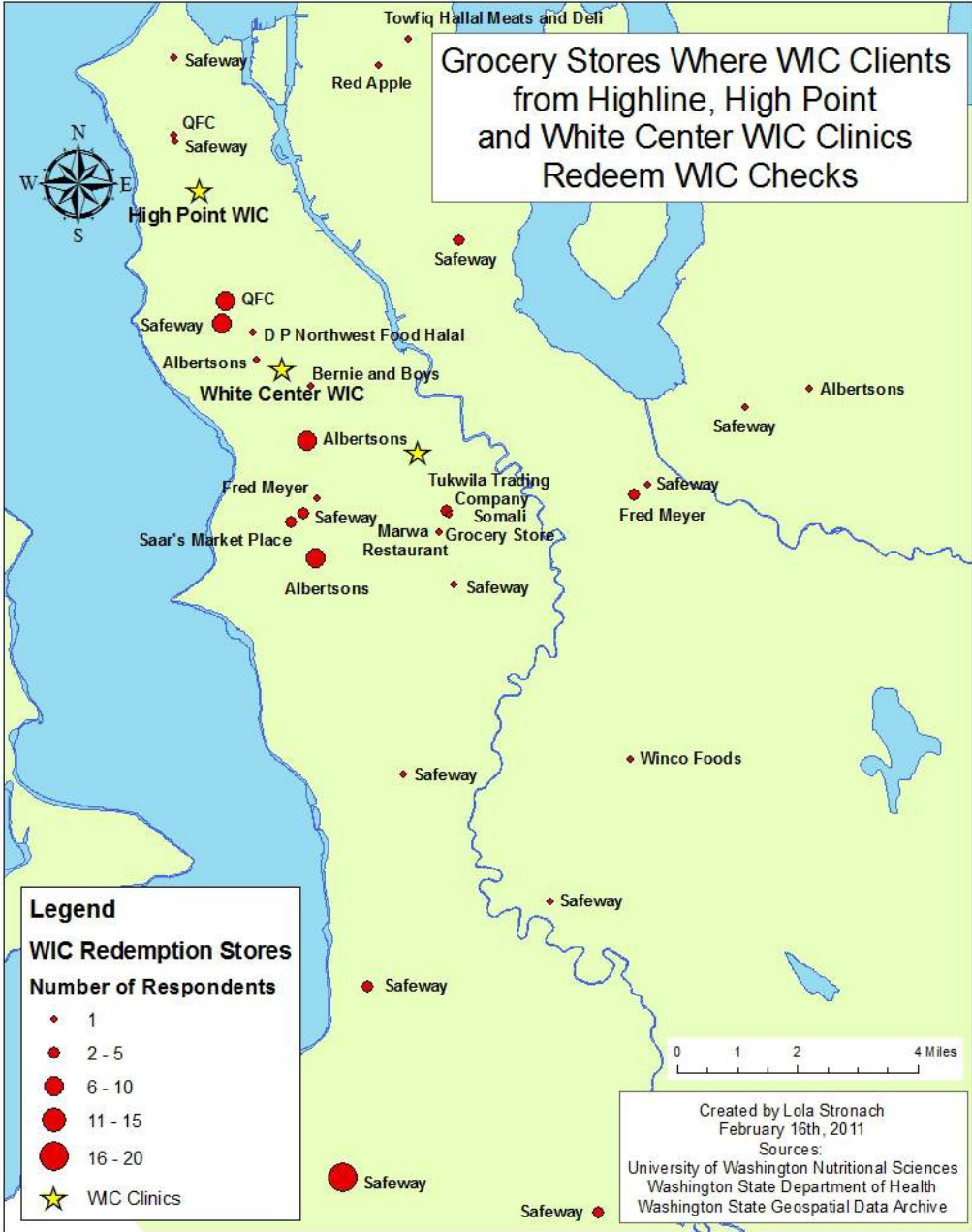


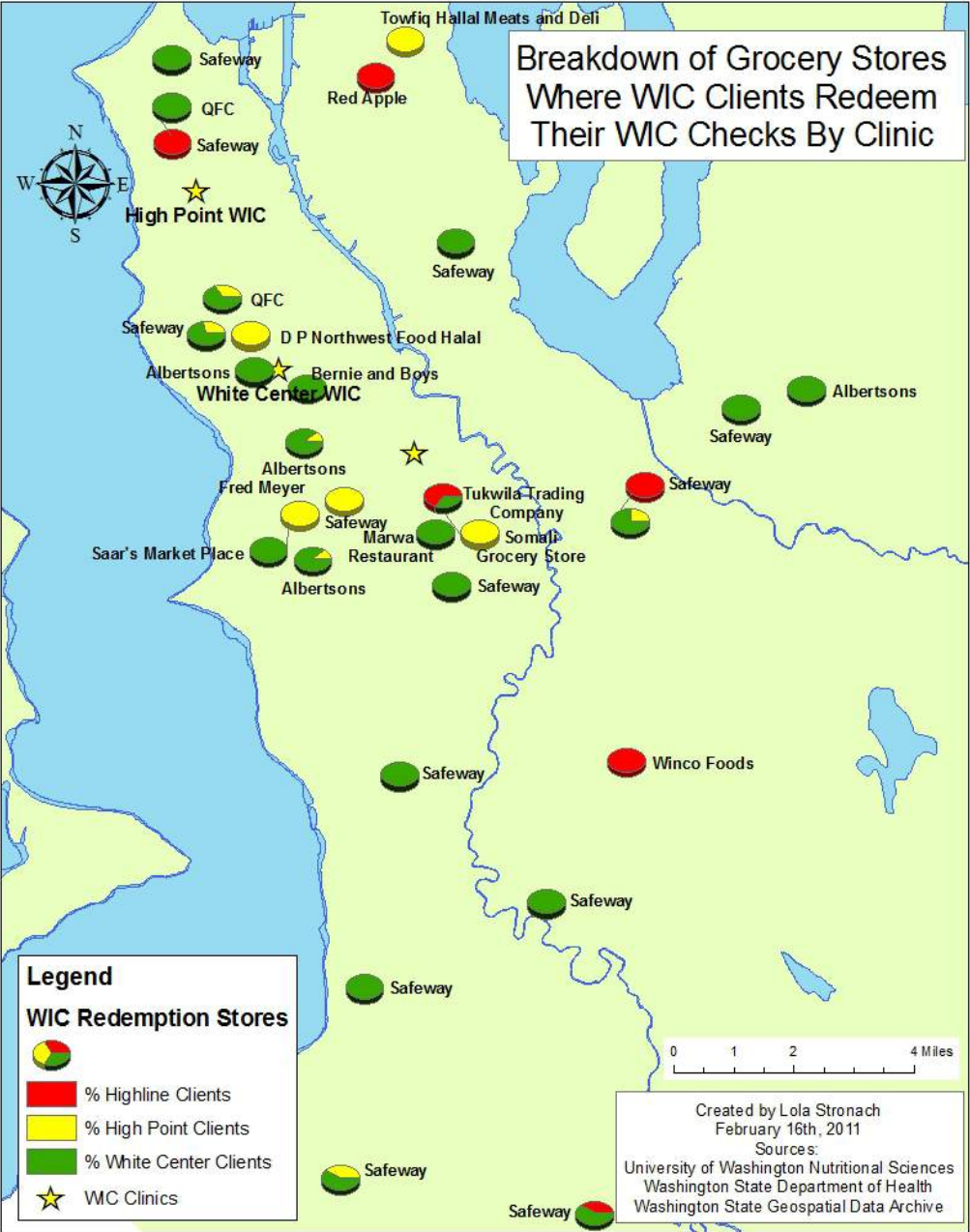

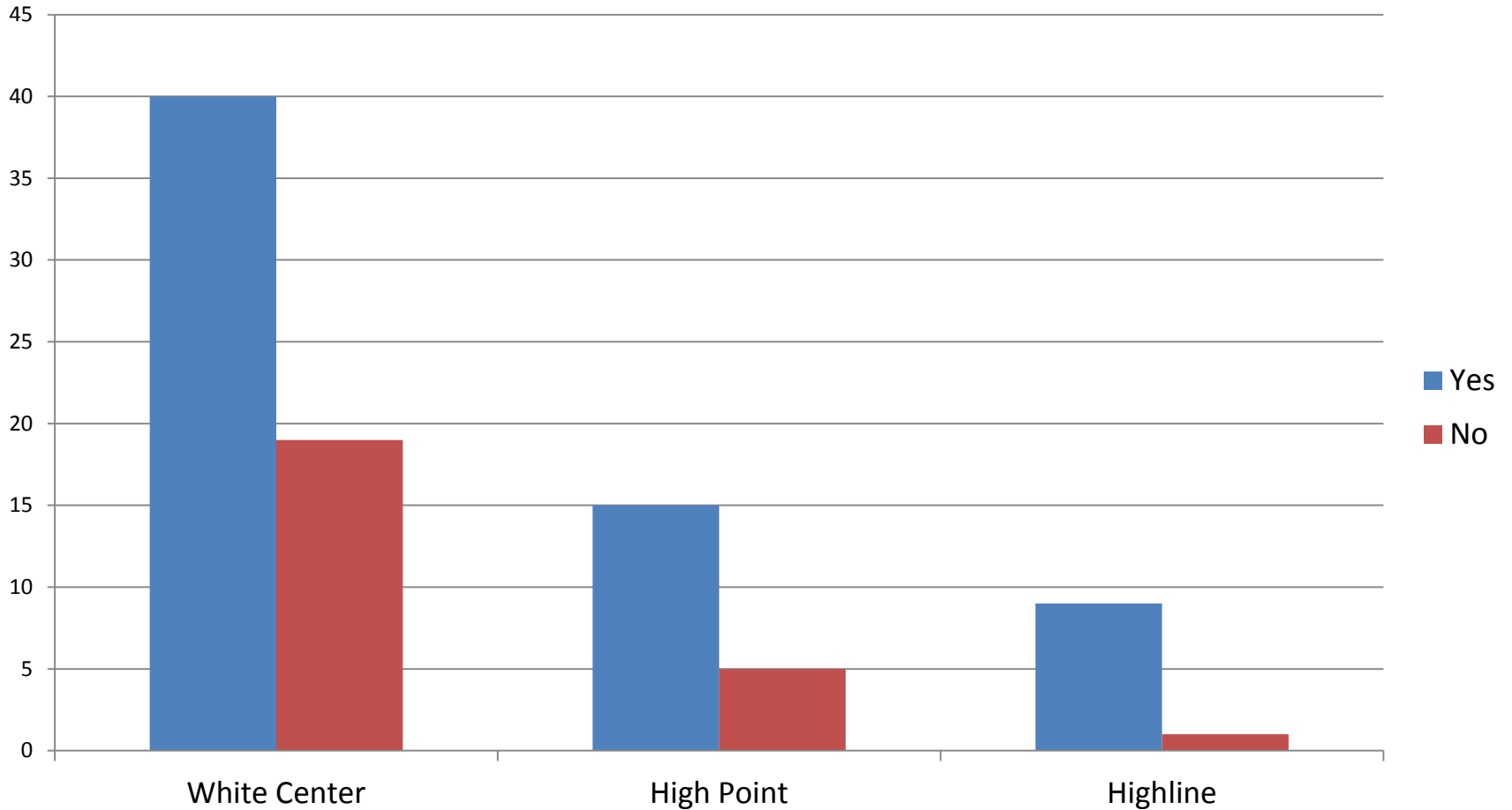
# Grocery Stores Where WIC Clients from Highline, High Point and White Center WIC Clinics Redeem WIC Checks



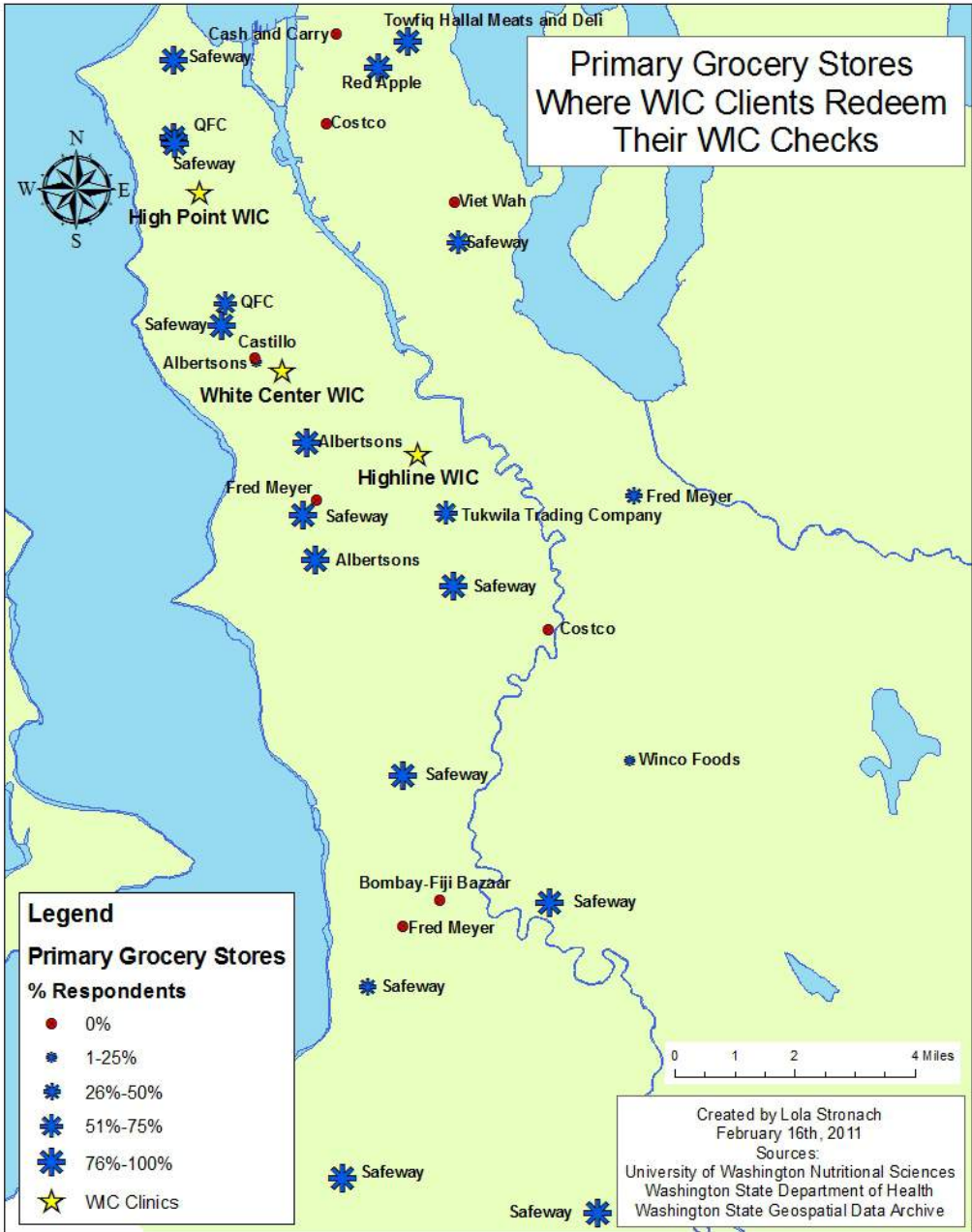




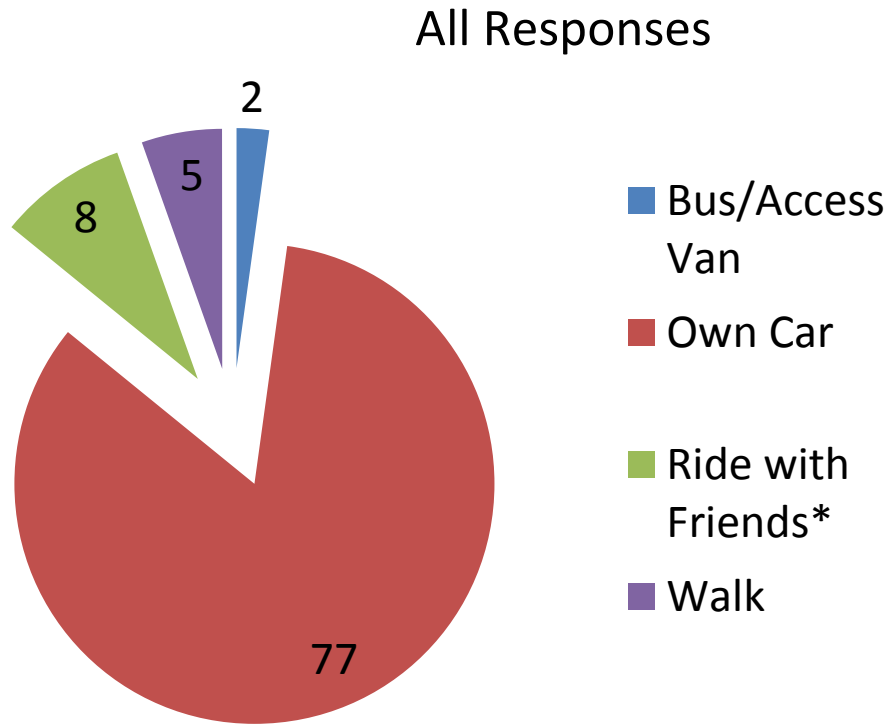

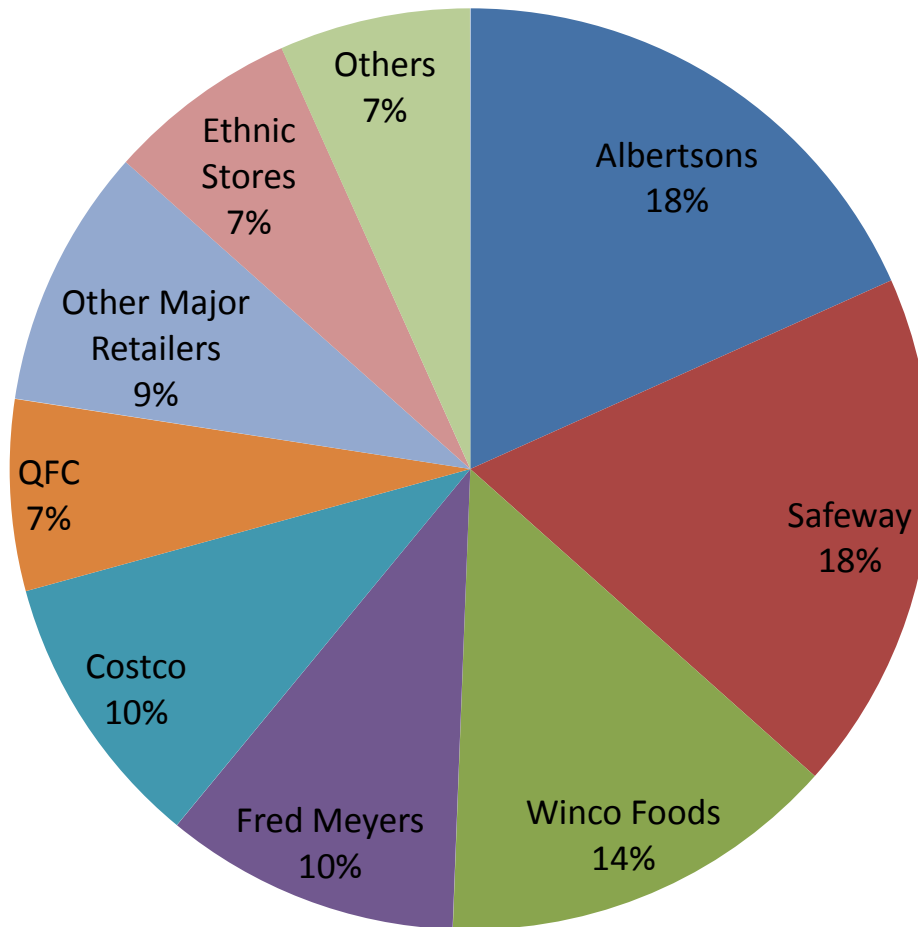

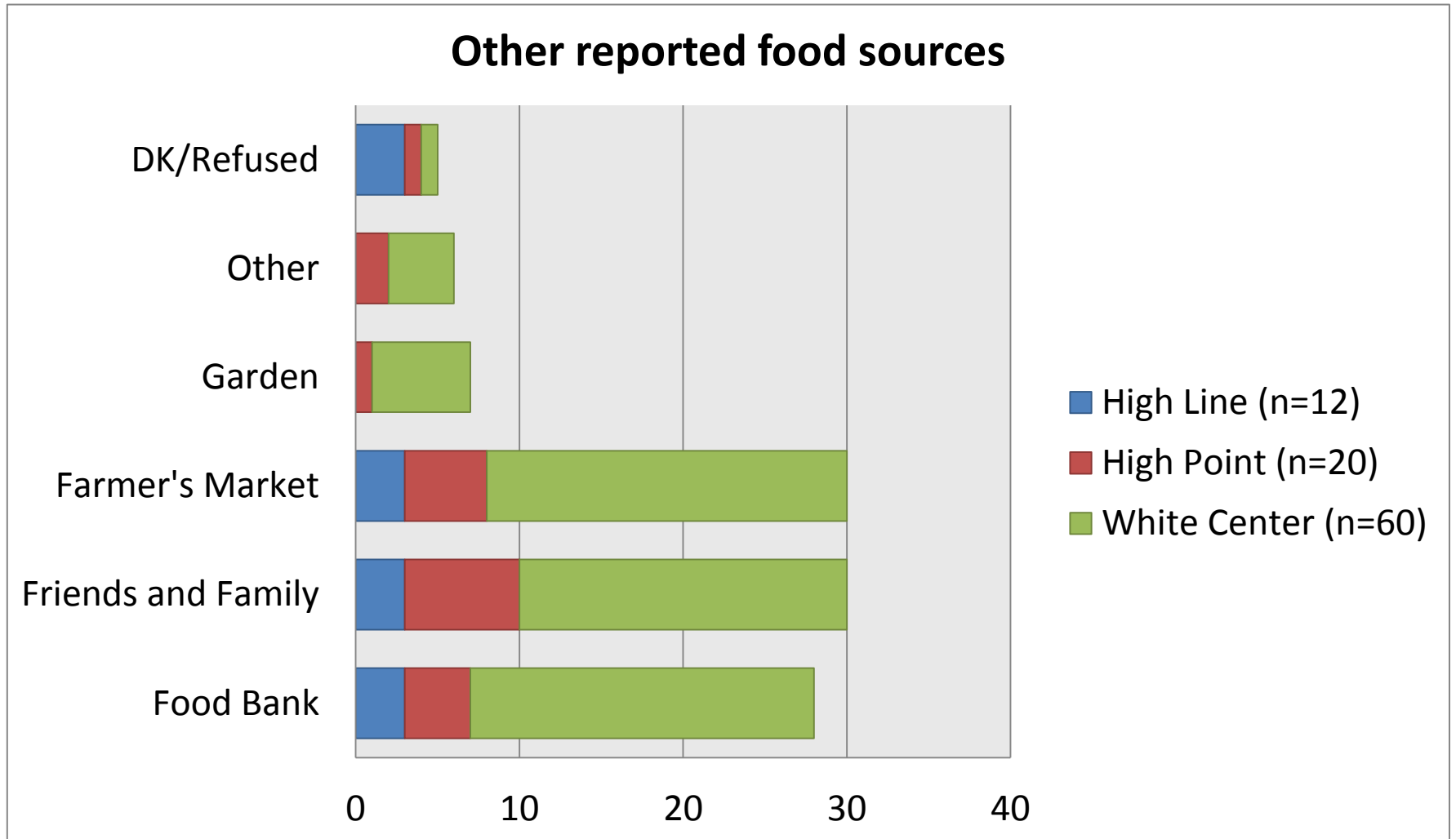

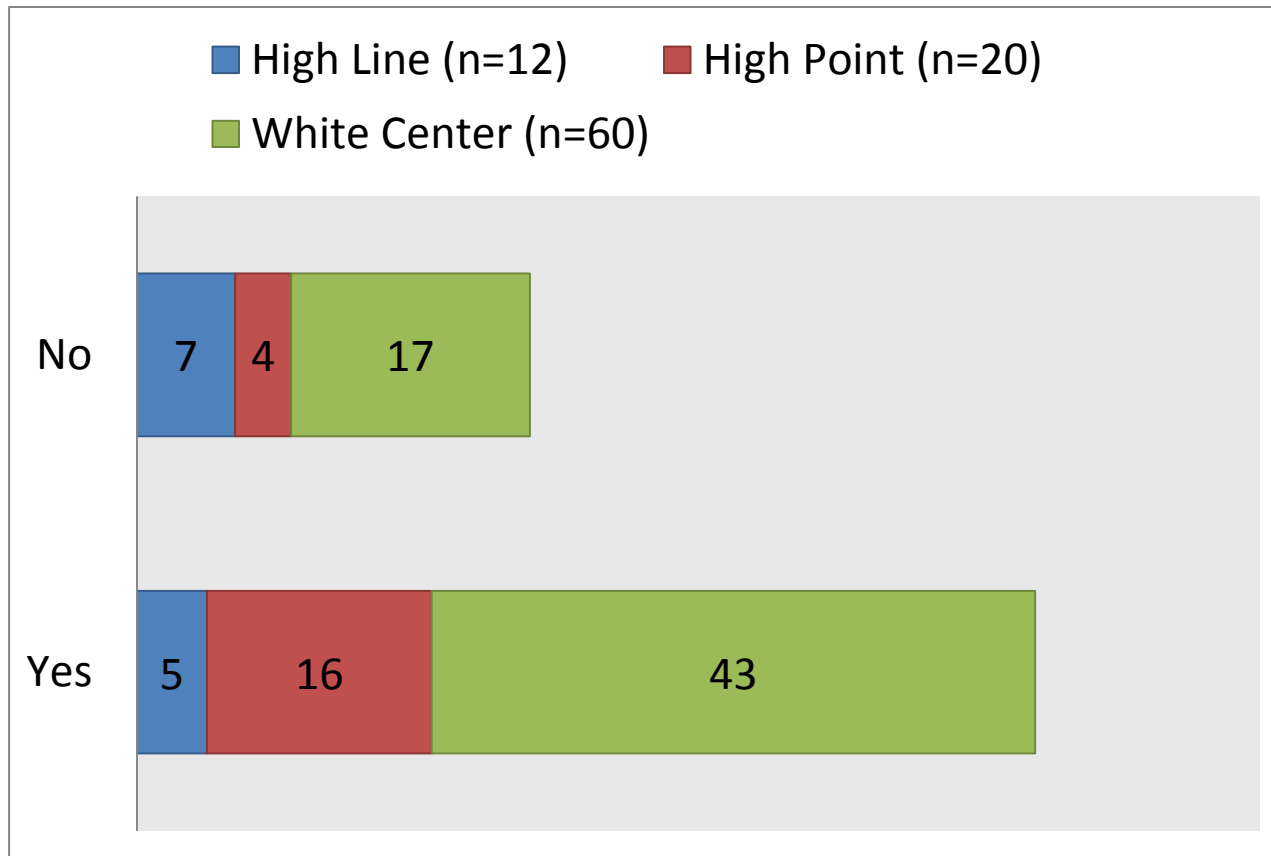

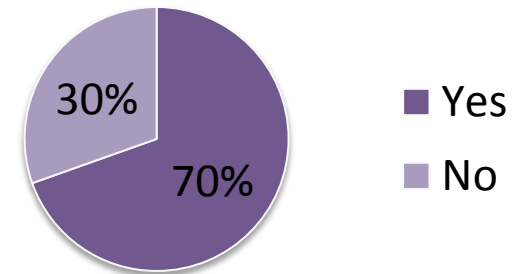
# Other reported places HH acquires food (item 8)



# In the past 12 months, did anyone in your HH receive SNAP? (item 9)



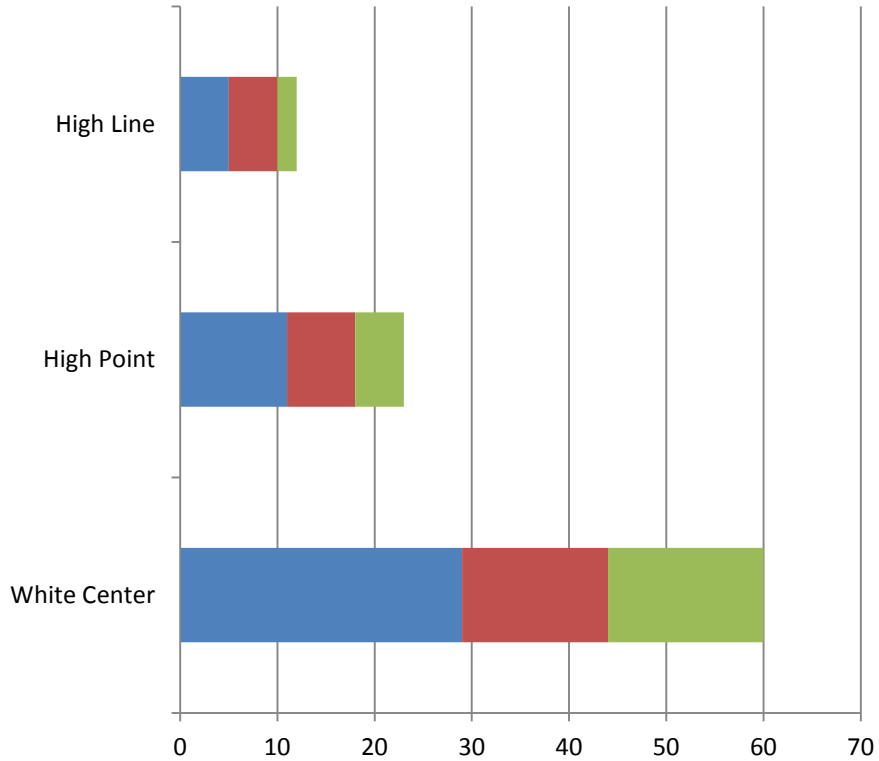

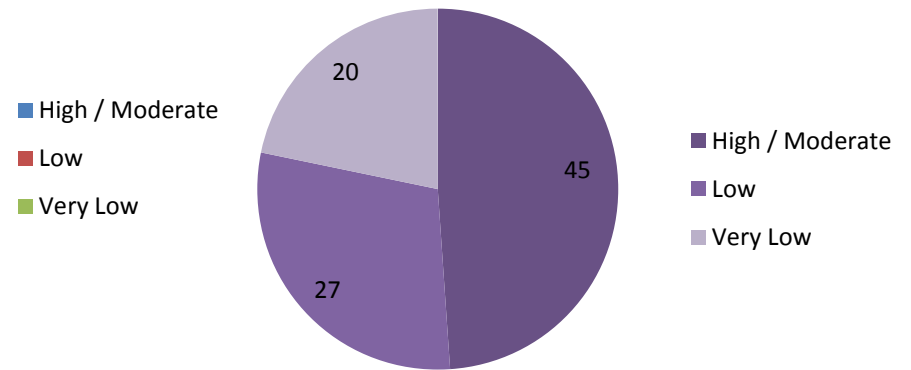

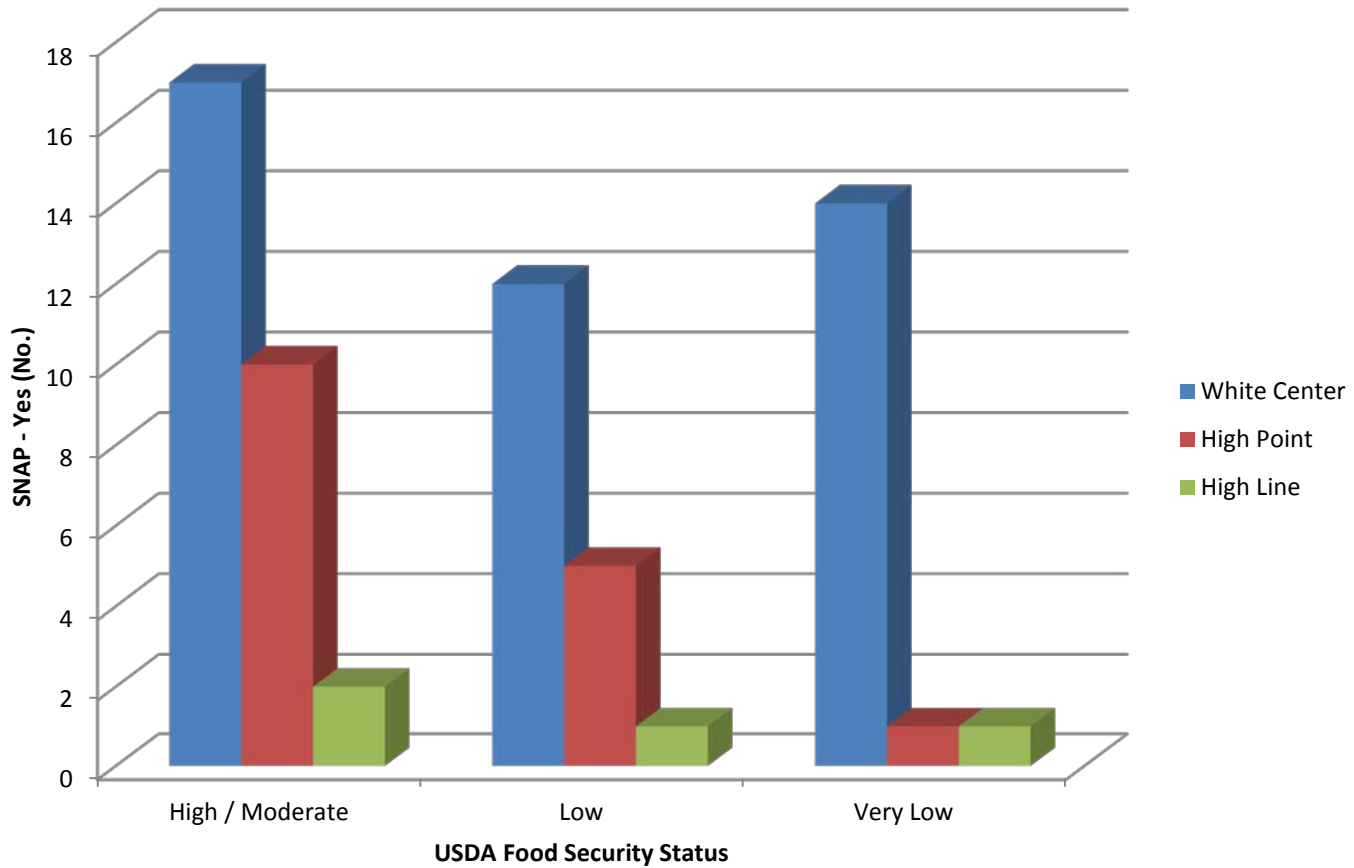

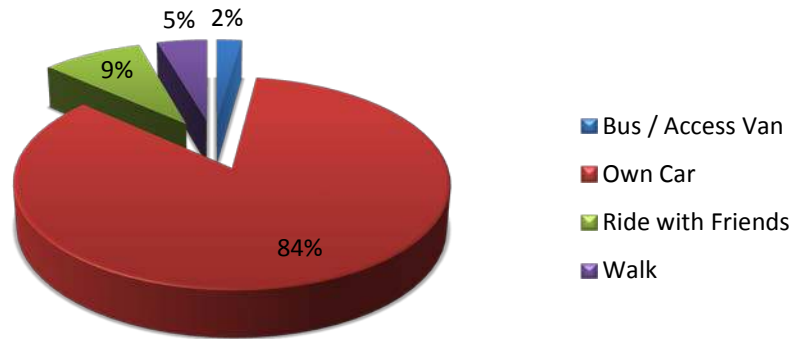


# USDA Food Security, by SNAP use

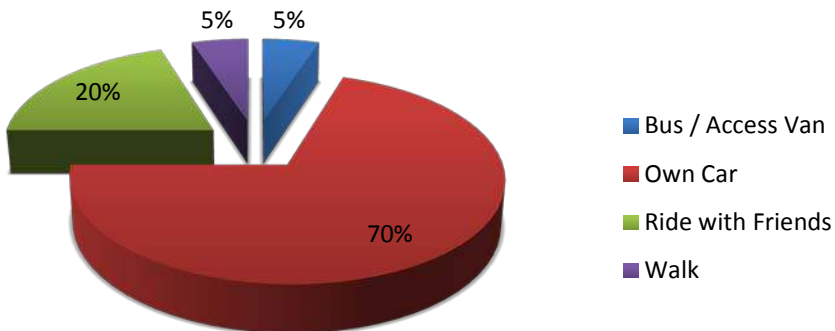


# USDA Food Security, by Method of Transport
