Both systems are supported by UW-IT and can be used both with *or without* the aid of Health Science room equipment, providing a great deal of flexibility for instructors. If desired, instructors can record lectures or host video conferences from their own device without needing to reserve Health Sciences spaces or borrow special equipment.

Please note that while we recommend this software for use, Health Sciences Classroom Services staff are not trained or equipped to provide detailed software support. Panopto Lecture Capture Software

For lecture recording and broadcasting, [Panopto](#) is the UW-IT supported lecture capture solution. Panopto allows for easy recording and reviewing of videos from courses, lectures, and presentations. As a cloud-enabled service, Panopto is designed to simplify the lecture capture process. Recordings in Panopto are viewable on most Web browsers and mobile devices, and can be easily inserted into Canvas pages. You install and run Panopto on your presentation laptop and it captures your presentation slides along with the lecture audio through the laptop microphone. It can also optionally capture video through any laptop camera if desired.

Zoom Video Conferencing Software

For situations where you want live interaction between participants, [Zoom](#) is the UW-IT supported video conferencing solution. Zoom provides high quality video, audio, and screen sharing across Windows, Mac, Linux, and mobile devices. The University has recently provided all faculty, staff, and students with access to Zoom Pro accounts, and the service does have HIPAA & FERPA compliant options.
