- MPH students must complete a minimum of 63 credits.
- GCPD students complete the required MPH Practicum (NUTR 595) by way of the NUTR 561 Practice Experience.
- All graduate students complete either a practice-based capstone with mentorship from a faculty instructor and a community partner or a research-based thesis under the direction of a faculty thesis chair and committee. This handout presumes you will be completing the NUTR 596 Nutrition Practice Capstone as your culminating experience requirement. The decision to pursue the capstone or thesis is typically made in winter and spring of the first year of study.
